Once upon a time, there was an anthropologist who proposed a game to African tribal children.



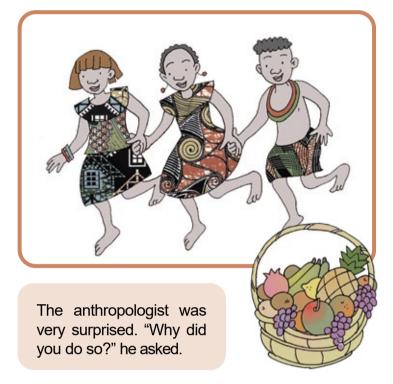
He placed a basket of delicious fruit near a tree, and then had them stand a few hundred feet away. Whoever reached the basket first would get all of them.
